The admissions procedure for the MA in Applied Theatre – Artistic Practice and Society consists of three parts:

1. Online registration from **1st February to 30th March, 2020**
2. Assessment of the submitted portfolios by the admissions panel until **1st May 2020**
3. Selection process in Salzburg by invitation (only after portfolio has been assessed positively), **11.-13. June 2020**

The following documents must be uploaded in full to register online:

- Bachelor's certificate (or graduation certificate from an equivalent course of study). If a Bachelor's certificate is not available, an enrolment certificate or official confirmation of the anticipated degree should be uploaded.
- Complete transcript of records for the Bachelor's degree including all subjects taken and grades awarded.
- Applicants with foreign documents must provide an official translation into German or English alongside the relevant original.
- Evidence of the successful completion of a course in the field of "Introduction to Academic Research". If no appropriate course of at least one hour per week per term has been completed this must be taken retrospectively within the first two terms at the Mozarteum University Salzburg (additional requirement).
- Proof of English skills (see link: http://www.moz.ac.at/pdf.php?id=379699&t=DOCUMENTS_STORE_MBL).
- Curriculum vitae in tabular form plus personal statement/letter of motivation.
- Evidence of work as an assistant or an intern placement in a relevant field of practice.
- Where appropriate a letter of recommendation (e.g. an evidence-based recommendation or a report by a teacher or theatre practitioner).

The following documents must, as part of the portfolio, be submitted until the deadline mentioned above (further informations are provided by e-mail after the successful registration):

- A portfolio with one to two artistic works (e.g. videos or documentation of candidates' own works) in order to provide an impression of these works that is also visual. Written concepts alone should not be submitted. Please send an USB-stick of Videos to Prof. Ulrike Hatzler, postal address Mirabellplatz 1, 5020 Salzburg, Austria. An online upload of your portfolio is not possible!
- A new concept, just designed for this application, for a work of applied theatre (e.g. a participatory project, a youth project, a performative intervention etc.). The concept should take up no more than one page of A4 plus any material in the form of images.
- A Bachelor's dissertation or equivalent academic thesis.
- A declaration in the following words: "I confirm that I conceived and completed the works presented in this portfolio myself."

Selection workshop

Basis of assessment: The second part of the admissions procedure consists of several practical sections in the form of a workshop and a conversation with the admissions panel.

Participation in procedure: Obligatory for all candidates whose portfolios have been assessed positively.

Invitations to the selection process will be issued approximately 2 weeks before the event.

Waiving admissions procedure: This is not possible.

Requirements of the procedure: The selection process in the form of a workshop consists of several practical sections (e.g. in the fields of improvisation, movement, the practice of instruction, research). Additionally a conversation will be

held with the admissions panel to explore the candidate's scenic/social imagination, discursive competence and conceptual potential.

We would like to point out, that, in case of disability respectively chronic disease, the University Mozarteum Salzburg offers different possibilities of support for the entrance examination and during the study.
